COMMUNICATION

COVID-19 updates will continue to be posted on our Website, Facebook and sent in emails to the primary adult in each family. This information can be found under the “COVID-19 updates” tab on our website www.lutherparkdanbury.com.



HEALTH SCREENING

Upon arrival, the families will undergo a quick health screening that will include taking temperature and asking about COVID symptoms and exposure.

Families and staff will be asked about COVID symptoms and have their temperature taken daily while at camp.



FACE MASKS

Face masks will be mandatory when:

- families, staff and guests are in indoor, public spaces, except when eating or sleeping.
- families, staff and guests are outside and social distancing is not possible.



SOCIAL DISTANCING

While at camp, families will be required to social distance at all times from other families, staff and guests. Reminders will be placed around camp, staff will help ensure distancing and certain precautions will be taken to help family pods, guests and people stay distanced (i.e.: during mealtime, during games, etc.).



DINING

Families will eat safely together mostly outside of the lodge, weather permitting. Meals will be served either by family style to the table or by plated buffet. Only kitchen staff or assigned camp staff will touch serving utensils. Each table will have all necessary condiments or other supplies needed for each meal. Anytime families are not eating or moving about in the meal space, a mask must be worn. Tables are spaced one table space apart to ensure social distancing.



LODGING

Each family will be staying in their own private lodging and will have access to their own bathroom. Public space within some of the lodging buildings may not be available for use during the families’ stay and families may be asked to enter and exit through their private entrances. (i.e.: The Retreat Center main living space may not be available to families if multiple families are staying in the Retreat Center and did not come to camp together).



SANITATION

All across Luther Park ministries, we are using a “Sani in/Sani out” method of sanitization. This means that every building and every activity has a “Sanitization in” and “Sanitization out” policy where a sanitization process of hands/supplies/etc. happens when entering and exiting a building and/or before and after the activity.
