COMMUNICATION

COVID-19 updates will continue to be posted on our Website, Facebook and sent in emails to the Retreat Group Leader. It is the responsibility of the retreat group leader to pass on important information to the rest of the group. This information can be found under the "COVID-19 updates" tab on our website www.lutherparkdanbury.com.



HEALTH SCREENING

Retreat guests will be asked to complete a one or two week pre-camp health screening before they arrive to camp. Information about this pre-camp screening will be sent in advance to the retreat group leader to then distribute before the retreat group is planned to arrive at camp.

Upon arrival, the retreat guests will undergo a quick health screening that will include receiving the pre-Screening document/information, taking temperature and asking about COVID symptoms and exposure.

Retreat guests and staff will be asked about COVID symptoms and have their temperature taken daily while at camp.



FACE MASKS

Face masks will be mandatory when:

- retreat guests, staff & other guests are in indoor, public spaces, except when eating or sleeping.
- retreat guests, staff and other guests are outside and social distancing is not possible.



SOCIAL DISTANCING

While at camp, retreat guests will be required to social distance at all times from each other. Guests within pods will also be asked to social distance as much as they can. Reminders will be placed around camp, staff and adults from the retreat group will help ensure distancing and certain precautions will be taken to help pods, guests and people stay distanced (i.e.: during mealtime, during games, etc.).



CAMP PODS

A "camp pod" is essentially a cabin group (a small group of retreat guests that are sharing a cabin/sleeping space with). Camp Pods are not required to wear a mask with each other. However, if Camp Pods gather to do a social distanced activity with other camp pods, face masks will be required for all participants.

For 2021, Camp Pods (cabin groups/non-masked groups) are suggested to be no more than 7 participants (including the adult) unless the proper health screening, quarantining and agreement is made with all group members, their parents/guardians and the Luther Park Staff. Retreat leaders are responsible for determining these groups.

Some large group activities that have traditionally happened at camp will not be happening this summer because there is no safe way to participate. However, camp staff have thought of creative, safe, large group activities where groups can socially distance and still participate as a large group.



CHECK-IN/PICK-UP

Unless prearranged by the group, Check-in/Pick-up will be done in a drive thru style. Families will stay in their car until directed by the Luther Park Staff. Families will be directed to different stations (check-in, health screening, etc.) that will be staffed by the Luther Park staff (and a retreat group adult, if necessary). Pick-up information will be provided to families via email from the group leader, as a specific plan is developed.



SANITATION

All across Luther Park ministries, we are using a "Sani in/Sani out" method of sanitization. This means that every building and every activity has a "Sanitization in" and "Sanitization out" policy where a sanitization process of hands/supplies/etc. happens when entering and exiting a building and/or before and after the activity.
